The Annual Meeting will be held at Lions Gate, 1110 Laurel Oak Rd., Voorhees, beginning at 7 p.m.

Levin, who is completing his first year as Voice president, is a longtime Voice board member and officer. He is a cardiologist with Penn Cardiology, practicing in Cherry Hill and at Penn Presbyterian Medical Center in Philadelphia. He first became involved with the Jewish Federation of Southern New Jersey through the Young Leadership Council (YLC), today known as the Young Adult Division (YAD). He chaired the YLC Leadership Development series. Along with his wife Andi, he co-chaired Super Sunday in 2001. He is a longtime member of the Board of Trustees of Jewish Federation and now serves on the Executive Board. He was the former chair of the Planning and Allocations Committee and currently is co-chair of the Budget and Allocations Committee. He also was a co-chair of the Jewish Medical Society.

Levin and his wife, who was recently installed for a second term as president of Samost Jewish Family & Children's Service (JFCS), reside in Cherry Hill with their children Michael, Rachel, and Samara. They are members of Temple Beth Shalom.
